Format - Scorecards/ Scoring:	<p>This is a Best Ball competition. Each player plays her or his own ball. Once it is clear your score will not be used for the hole, you should pick up and enter the score that you feel you would most likely have received, followed by an “x”. Each player MUST have a score recorded for each hole, <u>even if the player did not finish the hole.</u></p> <p>Each player’s index, handicap, flight and strokes per hole are on their scorecard. Please verify this for accuracy! You must report any errors to the tournament director or to the Rules Committee.</p>	
Local Rules, Course Markings, Rules Committee:	<p>Rules Committee Today: Sue Madej, Cynthia Pinkard & Nancy Serra</p> <p>1) Out of Bounds: marked by boundary fence on North 1, 2 & 5 & white stakes on driving range;</p> <p>2) GUR, Abnormal Ground Conditions, Environmentally Sensitive Areas (Free Relief):</p> <p>3) Drop Areas: None</p> <p>3) Yardage markers: - Denoted by 200-, 150- & 100-yd. markers located on cart paths.</p> <p>4) Pin Placements: Red – Front; White – Middle; Blue - Back</p> <p>If you’re unsure of a rule or how to proceed under the Rules of Golf, you may play a second ball in accordance with Rule 3-3. <i>Before signing and turning in your card, you must get a ruling from the Rules Committee to determine the correct procedure.</i></p>	
Rest Rooms	North 6 & West 6 Tee Areas	
MWGA Pace of Play & POP Tips:	<p>Remember to keep pace with the group in front of you. To avoid penalties, you should turn in your scorecard within 4:50 hours from the start of play and no more than 10 - 15 minutes after the group in front of you finishes. Tips: Share cart duties; decide club to use en route to your ball; Be ready when it’s your turn to play; Do not spend time looking for lost balls; Park cart behind the green; Put away clubs and mark scores at next tee; Take 30 seconds or less for each shot.</p>	
Tie-Breaking Procedure:	<p>Ties shall be broken by scorecard playoff on basis of best score on holes 10 thru 18, 13 thru 18, 16 thru 18 & hole 18, in this order. Thereafter, a coin toss determines winner.</p>
