Posting Scores

To play in MWGA events you should have a current, up-to-date index. Without a current index you will play at 85% of you index on record or at scratch. Please remember to post all scores by going to www.gam.org then login with your GAM username and password.

When posting scores you are to post your **adjusted** scores. Scores are adjusted for such things as ESC, unfinished holes, unplayed holes and conceded holes. To understand score and ratings adjustments, please refer to the Handicap and Indexes booklet that came in your membership package or visit the Posting Scores page on our web site at www.mwgolf.org/Posting_Scores10.htm .

When posting scores on the GAM website, the ESC Score box is automatically populated when players enter their hole-by-hole scores. If you are not entering hole-by-hole, your ESC score should be entered in the top Score box.
